



## SPELLING LISTS YEAR 1 – SUMMER 1

The children will be taught spelling rules in class each week following the Nelson English Spelling scheme. Below are the rules that we intend to cover each week and a **sample of the words** the children will encounter as **expected standard for their age**. The children will also be given two high frequency words to learn to spell each week. The amount of words the children will learn may vary depending on the difficulty of the rule they are learning. **The emphasis should be on their understanding of spelling rules and being able to apply them to any words, including words that are not on the list.** Therefore to extend your child further you may also wish to help them find and spell other words which include the sound(s) that they are learning each week. **Highlighted words** are the 'challenge words' for each spelling pattern. Words in **bold** are the high frequency words.
