House Conker Competition



We are holding our traditional 'House Conker Championship' for pupils in Year 4, 5 and 6 next week.

To enter, pupils need to bring in a conker on a string on Monday 15th October – it must not be baked or have any artificial coating and come with a signed permission slip (see below).

Staff on the top ball court will supervise the 'Conker Challenge' during break times on Monday 15th October and Tuesday 16th October. Those that enter will earn 10 House Points - first, second and third places will win points for their House Team.

Obviously, playing a traditional conkers game carries risk of minor injury and there is a good chance that hands may be hit by conkers – pupils that choose to enter should be prepared for this. Pupils will be guided about keeping game playing as safe as possible and shown how to stand, hold the conker etc. to minimise risks. Pupils will only play within their own year groups. Conkers will not be allowed out on the playground at any other times other than in the supervised House Championship.
